- The IOM Marathon / Half Marathon had record 374 local competitors

- The Syd Quirk Half Marathon had a record 400 competitors that had to be capped due to safety reasons
- Both Handicaps had record entries 103 competitors in total

Not to mention the other events such as Park runs, Fireman's runs and Fell runs etc

With the above in mind, I would like to recognise the outstanding work that is undertaken by my exceptional Executive Committee, Sub-committees, marshals, timekeepers, first aiders, sweepers and anyone else who is involved in the organisation of such great events. Without all of your support and hard work (in your own time), there would be no club or successful events that we organise throughout the year.

One of the highlights of 2020 was giving the Syd Quirk Half Marathon the love and attention that it had been missing. It is one half of our two official half marathon events that we put on each year and was always viewed as the poor relation. The entries speak for themselves and the feedback was fantastic and has set the precedent for future races.

On the subject of social media, our Facebook page went from 240 members to 444 members. We still continue our social media presence to advertise upcoming events and these also go across multiple club groups to so nobody misses out.
