Coupled with third walker home Phil Lockwood they took the team honours in a combined watch time of 41.53. Phil's actual time of 14.57 was the fastest time of the day ahead of Stuart Le Noury's 15.09.

Jayne Le Noury finished second walker home, well down on the winner, but breaking the 20 minutes barrier for the first time in many a year, recording an actual time of 19.54.
